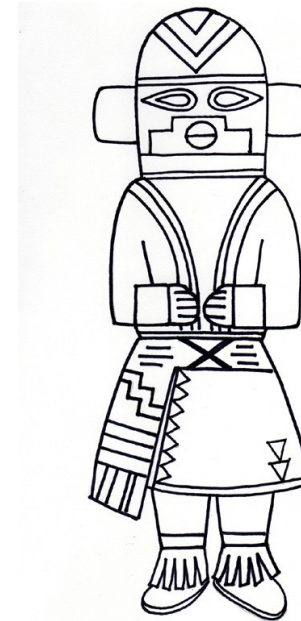

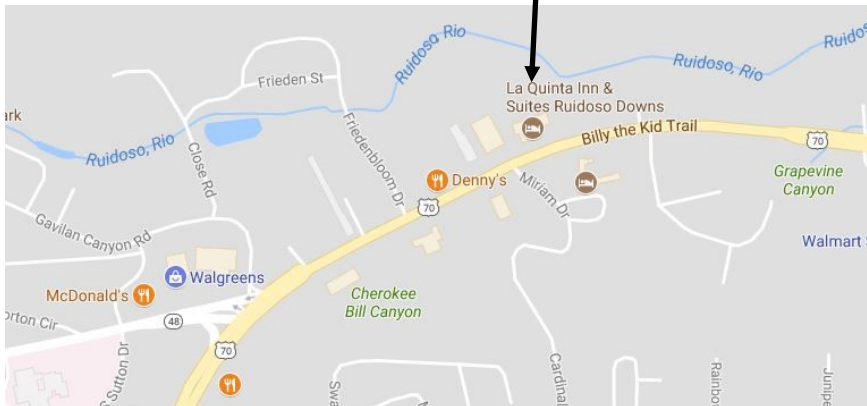

WALKS

Bring water. Hiking boots & poles will help.
All walks are \$3 each for IVV credit (no A awards)

May 30 - June 3: Cedar Creek Recreation Trails
5k, 11k and 20k - Rated 3B

Trails are in midtown Ruidoso through a national forest with start point behind Smoky Bear Ranger Station. Trails are through beautiful pine forest with several deer, especially early morning. Altitude is 7,500 feet.

Friday June 1: Cloudcroft Rails to Trails
5k and 14K - Rated 3B

Start point is 50 miles from hotel. Watch carefully for elk or cattle on the road. Trails are well maintained through pine forest and meadows. You will pass by 2 railroad trestles. Cloudcroft is a small mountain town, popular with hikers. Be sure to visit the Sacramento Mountain Historic Museum after the walk. Altitude is 8,500 feet.

Saturday June 2: Mescalero Fitness Path
5k and 10K - Rated 2A

Start point 9 miles from hotel, across from the Inn of the Mountain Gods on the Mescalero Apache Reservation. Trail is on a fitness path, with hills and wooded areas. There is a beautiful lake and a zipline. Enjoy lunch at one of several restaurants at the Inn of the Mountain Gods or the casino. Altitude is 7,000.

Sunday June 3: Fort Stanton NM State Monument
6k, 10K and 16K - Rated 3B

Start point is 30 miles from hotel. Trails are in a sparsely wooded area of rolling hills. A guided tour of Fort Stanton is available at 11am. The Fort is one of the most intact historic posts in New Mexico, and served for over 150 years, including its being a POW camp during World War II. Altitude is 6,500.
